EDUCATIONAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL CENTER NEWS: It's hard to believe but school resumes NEXT Tuesday, September 1. The teachers have been preparing very hard for the student's return and we are hosting a number of orientations and open houses so our students and families are ready for the big day. Please keep everyone in your thoughts and prayers throughout the new 2009-10 school year.

- ✦ **PRESCHOOL ENROLLMENT:** Preschool enrollment continues to be accepted for children 4 years of age. Enrollment into Spanish language classes is currently being accepted for the upcoming school year. Stay n' Play is available for childcare Monday-Friday for 3-5 year olds. To register a child, please call Nancy Simpson in the EDC Office, (636) 947-8778.
- ✦ **STAY N' PLAY REGISTRATION:** Registration for the 2009-2010 Stay n' Play year was on August 20. If you did not register your child, you may do so during the Parent Orientation meetings on Monday or by calling Nancy Simpson at (636) 947-8778 for more information.
- ✦ **PARENT/STUDENT ORIENTATION MEETINGS:** Preschool parent orientation meetings are scheduled on August 24th. The Pre-Primary I class will meet at 6:00 p.m., the Pre-Primary II classes will meet at 7:00 p.m., the Pre-Kindergarten classes will meet at 8:00p.m., and Supplemental class will meet at 9:00 p.m. The children will have an opportunity to meet their teachers and the Stay n' Play staff at Meet the Teacher Night on Wednesday, August 26th. Preschool and Stay n' Play will open on Tuesday, September 1st.
- ✦ **ALLERGY ISSUES:** A number of our incoming and returning students have severe food allergies to both "common" foods (peanuts, milk, etc.) but also "uncommon" foods (bananas, ranch dip, etc.). At this point it appears that the entire facility will need to be completely "peanut-free" and other steps may be necessary to ensure the health and safety of all our students.
